Out of an abundance of caution for the health and welfare of our students, teachers, and the community, and in light of the evolving COVID-19 situation, the Hawaii State Department of Education is announcing the cancellation of “Civic Sense 2020: A Forum for Hawaii’s Future.”

This event was scheduled to take place at the Hawaii State Capitol on Saturday, March 21, 2020. A [memo](#) has been posted on DOE Memos and Notices about this cancellation.

This decision was not made lightly, knowing the importance of such an event in advancing civic engagement in our schools; however, the safety of our students and staff is our highest priority.
