

Safety and Wellness Survey Data Report for School Year 2014-15

This report provides an assessment of school progress towards implementation of the Hawaii State Department of Education (DOE) Wellness Guidelines using data from the Safety and Wellness Survey (SAWS) school year (SY) 2014-15. Please see the attachments for a summary of the Wellness Guidelines Scores and a comprehensive list of school SAWS participation and scores.

The number of schools completing the SAWS in SY 2014-15 is 239 (94%) of 255 eligible schools. The participation rate across the state is very high and several complexes are reaching 100%. However, there are some areas where participation could be improved.

Hawaii's schools are implementing an average of 82.3% of the guidelines. There are 84 schools (35.1%) receiving awards for "Excellence in Wellness" by meeting 90% or more of the guidelines – a record level of achievement. The number of schools scoring 70% or lower is 41 (17.2%). The individual school scores range between 45.5 - 100%.

Schools are achieving high rates of compliance in many guidelines, with average scores at or close to 100%, but there are also some guidelines that could use additional support. All of the guidelines that relate to the school meals program and are the responsibility of the DOE School Food Services Branch (NS1, NS5, NH2, and NH3), are being fully implemented by 100% of schools. The guideline with the lowest score is NS2, which relates to the nutritional quality of foods and beverages provided to students outside of the meals program. The average scores on individual guidelines range between 40.2-100%.

The SAWS uses the following scoring criteria: one (1) point for a guideline that is fully met or zero (0) for a guideline not met. In SY 2014-15, the number of points possible is 22 for elementary and 23 for secondary schools; PA2 applies to secondary schools only. The overall score is calculated by dividing the number of points achieved by the total points possible.

The SAWS is an online survey administered annually to principals at public (non-charter) schools to measure school-level adherence to the Wellness Guidelines and evaluate health and safety programs. The Wellness Guidelines operationalize the Hawaii State Board of Education's Health, Wellness, and Safety Policy 1110-6. This report fulfills requirements of Public Law 111-296, Sec. 204 and the Healthy,

Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010. Some of the SAWS data may not be comparable across years due to modifications in the survey and scoring criteria.

CD1	78.2%	The school has a designated committee or council that will regularly address school health issues.
CD2	52.7%	The committee annually completes the School Health Index and utilizes the results and other data sources to identify priority areas and to monitor improvements in those areas.
