At Mililani High School, your child's safety is of our utmost concern.

Our school received a bomb threat, and at approximately 10:20 a.m. this morning, all buildings were evacuated as a safety precaution. The Honolulu Police Department (HPD) responded immediately. They investigated, a full sweep was conducted, and it was determined that there was no credible threat. After consultation with HPD, an all-clear was given at approximately 11 a.m. and students were returned to their classes. HPD is continuing its investigation.

All threats to our school or students are taken very seriously and investigated thoroughly. We wanted you to have the facts so you can discuss them with your child and emphasize the seriousness of this issue. If you discover anything that can assist in the investigation, please contact us immediately. You can also make an anonymous report to Honolulu Crimestoppers at 955-8300.

The safety of our students is a priority. We are committed to providing a secure campus. I would like to commend our staff, teachers, parents and students for their prompt response and cooperation during today's incident.
