<u>Purpose</u>: To provide a mechanism for proposing, addressing, tracking and maintaining issues related to data governance which cannot be resolved at an individual level or which have conflicting concerns and/or interests that impact institutional processes and effectiveness. Issues may include, but are not limited to data security, privacy, quality, access, standardization, and definition.

Employees - in program or IT capacities - who work directly with the data to collect, use or report the data. Open membership.

- Issue identification and escalation
- Propose options for resolution to Data Stewards
