Dear Parent(s)/Legal Guardian(s):

Thank you for your support in ensuring that your child is healthy and ready to learn.

Hawaii Revised Statutes §302A-1155 requires that all students meet physical examination, immunization, and tuberculosis (TB) clearance requirements before they may attend a childcare facility, preschool, or public/private school in the State of Hawaii (Attachment A – Important Notice to Parents).

You are receiving this notice because school records indicate that your child does not currently meet the school entry requirements this year. Please review Attachment B – Notice of Incomplete Health Requirements Form which indicates what specific requirements are necessary for your child to start the new school year.

If your child has already received the missing immunizations, physical exam, and/or TB clearance indicated in Attachment B, please submit records to your child's school as soon as possible. If you do not have the records, contact your child's healthcare provider to obtain a copy.

If your child is still in need of the missing immunizations, physical exam, and/or TB clearance indicated in Attachment B, please schedule an appointment with your child's healthcare provider as soon as possible. Proof of appointment to obtain the missing requirement(s) will be accepted to allow for school entry.

If your child does not currently have a healthcare provider, please review Attachment C – Community Health Centers. If you need further assistance, please contact the health centers directly.

Should you have any questions, please contact the administrative office at your child's school.
