Requirements for Baselines & Targets

Baselines	Targets
<p>State can reset the baselines if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Calculation methodology changed.• Data measurement method or process is revised.	<p>Targets Must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be rigorous, yet achievable.• Show improvement over baseline.• Be set with the advice of stakeholders.• Be rooted in, and build on, past experience when possible.

What Does Indicator 11 Measure?

- Indicator 11 measures the percent of children whose initial evaluations were completed within 60 days upon receipt of parental consent. §300.301 (c)(1)(i)
- Target for this indicator is **100%** compliance.





Importance of Indicator 11

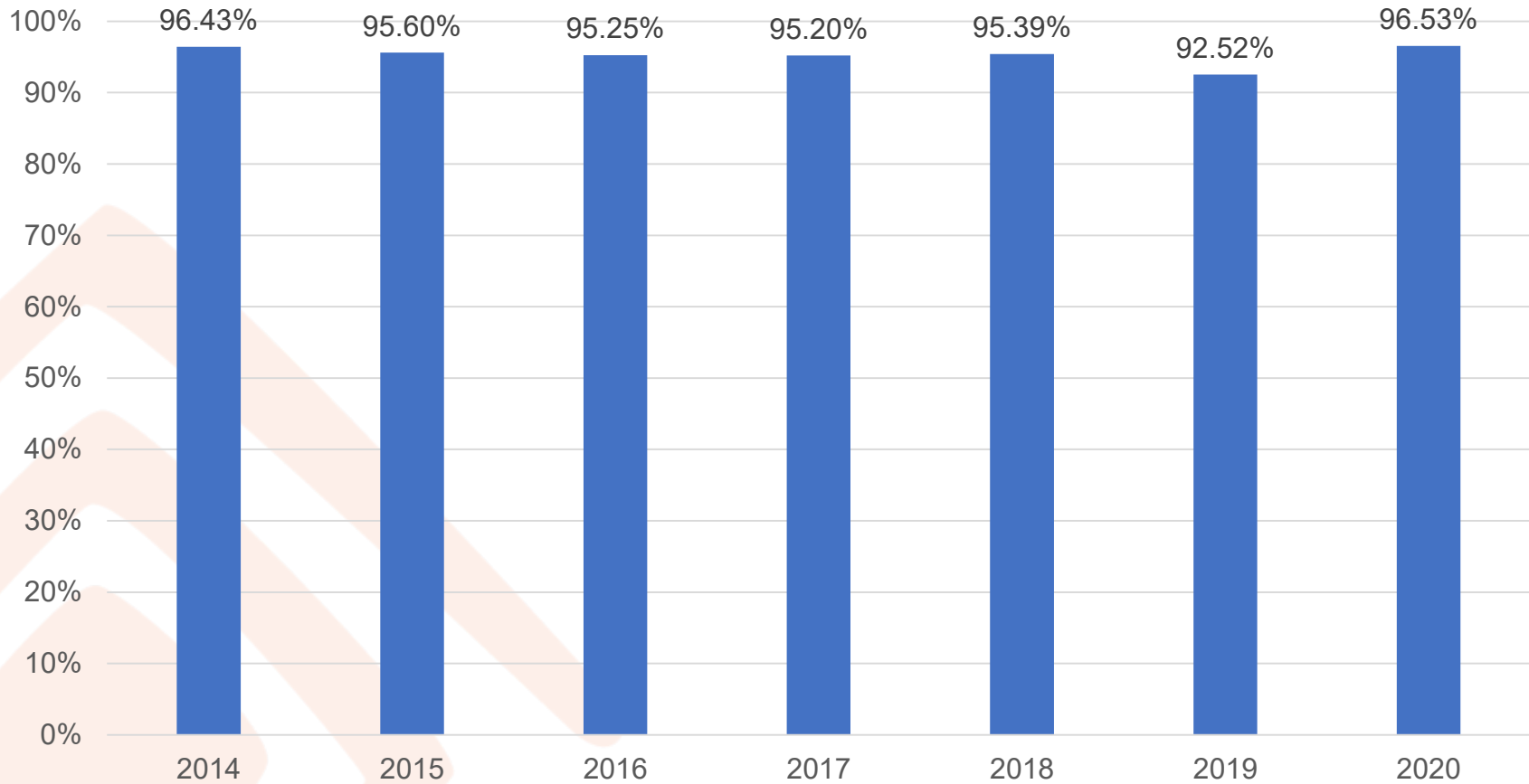
Critical first step in ensuring that we fulfill the purpose and spirit of IDEA.
