- The State Performance Plan (SPP)/Annual Performance Report (APR) is developed in six year intervals.
- It is a single document that measures the State's efforts in meeting the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 (IDEA).

Requirements for Baselines & Targets

Baselines

State can reset the baselines if:

- Calculation methodology changed.
- Data measurement method or process is revised.

Targets

Targets Must:

- Be rigorous, yet achievable.
- Show improvement over baseline.
- Be set with the advice of stakeholders.
- Be rooted in, and build on, past experience when possible.



What is Indicator 16?



Percent of mediations held that resulted in mediation agreements.



What about Mediation?

1. Mediation is voluntary; both the school and parent must agree to use mediation.
2. Mediation is provided at no cost to the parents and schools.
3. Mediation may not be used to deny or delay a parent's right to a due process hearing or to deny any other right under Part B of IDEA.
4. In mediation, the focus is on establishing collaboration and communication between the parties.



How We Measure Indicator 16?

<p>Numerator: (2.1(a)(i)) Mediation agreements related to due process complaints + (2.1(b)(i)) Mediation agreements not related to due process complaints</p>	\div	<p>Denominator: (2.1) Mediations held</p>	$\times 100$	<p>= Percent of mediations held that resulted in mediation agreements.</p>
---	--------	---	--------------	--

Measurement: Percent = (2.1(a)(i) + 2.1(b)(i)) divided by 2.1) times 100.

Data Includes:

- (2.1): Mediations held
- (2.1(a)): Mediations held related to due process complaints
- (2.1(a)(i)): Mediation agreements related to due process complaints
- (2.1(b)): Mediations held not related to due process complaints
- (2.1(b)(i)): Mediation agreements not related to due process complaints

<p>0 mediation agreement related to due process complaints + 2 mediation agreements not related to due process complaints</p>	\div	<p>4 mediations held</p>	$\times 100$	<p>50%</p>
