## LEGISLATIVE REPORT

SUBJECT: Superintendent's Fund

REFERENCE: Act 160, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006 Section 47.2

**ACTION** 

REQUESTED: The department of education shall submit a report on the expenditures

made pursuant to this section.

DOE REPORT: Funds were allocated to provide assistance to schools with an August

Official Enrollment Count significantly below the enrollment projection

used to develop their Academic and Financial Plan (AFP).

Any school that saw a reduction of more than two percent from their School Year 2006-2007 AFP had 21.95% of that reduction restored from these funds. See Attachment, Report on Superintendent's Fund, for

further details.

ANALYSIS OF

THE DATA: This is the first year of implementation and thus no trends can be derived

from this data. The total number of schools seeing a reduction as a result of August OEC was 25. The net loss for these schools was \$4.5 million,

of which this \$1 million covered 21.95%.

FINDINGS: Legislative "foundation funds" helped to offset a portion of the losses.

Without them, the net loss for these schools would have been \$6.5 million. With the "foundation funds" and the contingency fund, those losses were

reduced to \$3.5 million.

RECOMMEND-

ATIONS: The Department recommends that the Superintendent continue to have

flexibility to help address unpredicted shifts in school funding as a result of unforeseen enrollment changes. A larger amount of funding would

provide even greater mitigation.
